Key actions/activities

- Lifting up immigrants and refugees through prayer and special time of worship.
- Providing opportunities for members of the congregation to assist in urgent response efforts in the case of a family facing deportation or detention, through outreach and education, advocacy campaigns, fund raising efforts, logistic support and other forms of voluntary engagement.
- Participating in resource gathering activities in the form of food, clothing or other supplies for immigrant families in emergencies. This includes services for families facing separation or displacement, for example, transportation to medical appointments and school.
- Building relationships and providing solidarity and financial support for other churches who are directly involved in offering shelter or services for immigrants in need.
