Purpose/Overview of role

The Green Wood Worship Leader/Music Director is responsible for planning, providing, and leading music for the weekly Saturday worship service in coordination with the clergy staff. This is an ideal position for an experienced self-starter.

Key Responsibilities

- Lead weekly worship service including congregational singing, transitions between segments of the service
- Provide special music and music as the service starts and ends
- Plan thematically-appropriate music for each Saturday evening service in coordination with clergy and worship team
- Work with volunteer singers and small band to prepare them for worship
- Right of first refusal to provide music for memorial services and weddings held at Green Wood
